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	17-06-2022	<p>Complaint No. <u>FOH-HQR/0000118/2022</u></p> <p>Ex-parte evidence already recorded. Record perused.</p> <p>As per register haqdaran-e-Zameen year 2010-11 of Mahal Koral, Tehsil & District Islamabad, the Complainant Shazia Begum D/o Alam Din (Complainant) is recorded owner in possession of 9/248 shares in khewat No. 181, 182 & 183, khasra No. 350, 357, 358, 352 & 355. She is shown to have been alienated in her name the area measuring 11¼ marla out of the above mentioned khwat & khasra numbers.</p> <p>In the above background, the Complainant has approached this forum under the Enforcement of Women's Property Rights Act 2020 praying to deliver her possession of the property that has been illegally occupied by her brothers Muhammad Hameed, Muhammad Jamil Ahmed and Shakil Ahmed. The Complainant requested to get her share separated because her husband has already constructed a house on that land spending big amount.</p>

		<p>Respondents were summoned through different means including the local police but they did not turn up. Hence placed ex-parte.</p> <p>The Complainant produced ex-parte evidence appearing herself as PW 1 besides producing Shahid Mehboob and Sapparish Khan as PW 2 and PW 3 respectively. Affidavits in evidence were produced as Ex PW 1/1, Ex PW 2/1 and Ex PW 3/1 for supporting the claim of Complainant.</p> <p>For the reason, that the revenue record placed on the file supports the claim of ownership of the Complainant and that none else is there to contest the claim of the Complainant, I, while invoking the provisions of section 4 and 5 of the Enforcement of Women’s Property Rights Act, 2020 hold that the Complainant has been illegally deprived of the ownership or possession of her property and as such she is entitled to the possession of her share as per revenue record. Accordingly I direct the Deputy Commissioner, Islamabad to take steps so as to restore possession of the property to the Complainant and after doing the needful to submit compliance report within seven days to this office in respect of implementation of the above orders.</p> <p>Adjourned to 27-06-2022 for compliance report.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">FEDERAL OMBUDSMAN</p>
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
