It shows that respondents are no more interested to pursue the instant case rather they are accepting the inquiry report submitted by DC office Islamabad. As per this report house No. 174, Street No. 7A, section G-11/2, Islamabad was devolved upon Mr. Asif Ali as a legal heir of Ms. Bismillah, his mother and after the demise of Mr. Asif Ali his inheritance devolved upon his widow Ms. Yasmin Asif and daughter Kiran Asif according to their respective shari shares.</p> <p>Respondents have already expressed their willingness to pay the shari share out of the suit house to the present Complainants. Respondents have also shown their readiness to hand over house hold articles to the Complainant lying in the said premises. As regards the motor car in question, it is not in the name of the decease husband of the Complainant while on the other hand it is in the name of respondent No. 3 who</p>

purchased it from one Zakir Iqbal. The claim of the Complainant about the said vehicle is, therefore, declined.

In view of above while invoking the provision of section 5 of the Enforcement of Women's Property Rights Act, 2020 I direct Deputy Commission concerned to take steps to restore or confer possession or title of the property to the Complainant including measures to perfect such title. Concerned DC shall submit the compliance report within seven days to this forum in respect of the implementation of the above order.

Adjourned to **07-01-2022** for compliance report.
